A Member entitled to attend and vote at the above meeting is entitled to appoint a proxy or one or more proxies to attend and, on a poll, vote in his place. A proxy need not be a member of the Company.

Forms of Direction from holders of depositary interests must be deposited at the office of the Registrar, Capita Registrars, The Registry, 34 Beckenham Road, Beckenham, Kent BR3 4TU, United Kingdom not later than 72 hours before the time of the meeting. Proxies from holders of common shares must be received by the Registrar not later than 48 hours before the time of the meeting.

The Company, pursuant to regulation 41 of the Uncertificated Securities Regulations 2001, specifies that only those shareholders registered in the register of members of the Company by no later than 48 hours before the time fixed for the meeting shall be entitled to attend or vote at the meeting in respect of the number of common shares registered in their name at that time. Changes in entries on the relevant register of members after such time and date shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend or vote at this meeting.
